PROCLAMATION TERMINATING FIRE-RELATED EMERGENCY DECLARATIONS

WHEREAS, on September 10, 2020, I declared a State of Emergency in the City of Portland due to the extreme threat of wildfires, and that emergency declaration was later extended through October 8, 2020; and

WHEREAS, on September 14, 2020, I declared a State of Emergency in the City of Portland for the emergency placement of displaced persons due to wildfire, and that emergency declaration was later extended through October 8, 2020; and

WHEREAS, PCC 15.04.040.E provides that an emergency declaration shall be terminated by proclamation of the Mayor when the emergency no longer exists or the threat of an emergency has passed; and

WHEREAS, I find the requirements of PCC 15.04.040.E are satisfied and therefore the fire-related declarations of emergency should be terminated as set forth below.

THEREFORE, pursuant to my authority under the Portland City Charter, City Code, and any other applicable law, I hereby Proclaim as follows:

1. The State of Emergency declared on September 10, 2020, and extended through October 8, 2020, due to the extreme threat of wildfires is hereby terminated effective immediately, together with any and all orders issued under the authority of the emergency declaration; and

2. The State of Emergency declared on September 14, 2020, and extended through October 8, 2020, for the emergency placement of displaced persons due to wildfire is hereby terminated effective immediately, together with any and all orders issued under the authority of the emergency declaration.
